Additional Trip Information

- 6/11** There is a 10-hour off-duty period that ends midnight (start of the day).
- 6/14** Adverse driving condition encountered at 1330. A gravel truck overturned in the road. Driver used the full two hours of additional driving time. At 1630, the driver arrives at the receiver and delivers her load.
- 6/18** Adverse driving condition encountered at 1200. An unexpected ice storm hits the area. Driver used 15 minutes of additional driving time to find a safe place to park.

Additional Trip Information

- 6/11** There is a 10-hour off duty period that ends 0215.
- 6/13** Adverse condition encountered at 1830, a tornado knocks trees down across the freeway. At 2030, the driver stops to re-tarp his load for ½ hour, and resumes driving at 2100. His driving is slowed due to debris on the road. The driver qualifies for 2 full hours of additional time.
- 6/14** The driver delivers his load at the receiver at 0730.
- 6/15** The driver was previously stopped on this date for an inspection at 0930.
- 6/18** The driver is stopped for inspection at 0700.
