#### 1033 LESO Program Annual Inventory Certification Due 12/15/16

As you know, the 1033 LESO Program annual inventory certification process is due Thursday, 12/15/16.

If any single agency in Colorado has not completed the online certification by the deadline, then the entire state will be suspended from acquiring equipment until the certification is completed by every participating agency.

Statewide accountability benefits every agency. Therefore, one late agency will hold up the entire state. Don't be that agency!

This is our opportunity to clean up the online records so that

they match the physical world. Contact our office to correct any discrepancies between the physical and online inventory numbers.

We have made great progress so far. As of 11/21/16, 106 agencies have completed the process and an additional 10 agencies have started the process.

Three things are necessary to complete the inventory certification:

 Current State Plan of Operation signed by the Chief or Sheriff

2. Physical inspection of

items on the agency's 1033 inventory list

 Completion of the online certification on FAMWEB LESO FEPMIS.

After physically inspecting equipment, the simple online process takes about 10 minutes for most agencies to complete.

#### **1033 LESO Armored Trucks Available for Transfer**

Two Peacekeeper Armored Personnel Carriers are available for transfer through the 1033 LESO Program. These trucks feature armor plating and bullet-resistant glass to keep officers safe. Both trucks run and drive, are considered in good condition, and were built in the 1980s.

#### **1033 LESO Rifles Available for Transfer**

We have a large quantity of both M14 and M16 rifles available for transfer through the 1033 LESO Program.

Overall, the rifles are in good, usable condition, ready to be issued to officers in your agency. Rifles are available in multiple locations around the state.

#### What is the KEYWORD notice on RTD equipment searches?

If you have searched for equipment on the <u>DLA</u> <u>External Business Portal</u>, <u>Reutilization-Transfer-</u> <u>Donation (RTD) website</u> recently, chances are that you have encountered a new <u>KEYWORD</u> flag on select items.

This is a new feature to alert users that they may be requesting a controlled or

prohibited item. Like any new system, it is a little rough at the start. Many more items are flagged than are actually prohibited. Most requested items are not prohibited.

As you can see in the below example, an intrenching tool carrier has been flagged with the <u>KEYWORD</u>, but this is not a prohibited item.

You can still request items that have the <u>KEYWORD</u> flag, as long as they are not on the prohibited list.

#### **Request Justifications**

Every request for an item through the 1033 LESO Program must be justified, explaining why the agency should be awarded the item.

What makes a good justification? Remember to address **Three Points:** 

- The item must be for use by the requesting law enforcement agency (no requesting items to give away).
- The item must be for a law enforcement purpose or use (no requesting items for other purposes).

 The justification must be convincing (make sure the justification matches the item).

This page and the next page contain some examples of good justifications from Colorado.

Item: Agitator, Paint, Shaker

Justification: This item will be utilized by the PD graffiti removal task force to mix paint cans prior to removal of graffiti. Item: Flashlight

Justification: These would be used by members of a law enforcement SWAT team to locate and identify potential threats when conducting drug enforcement operations during low light conditions.

#### Item: Truck, Carryall

Justification: We would like to use this SUV as a mobile police surveillance vehicle and outfit it with several camera systems. The car will be used in bait operations, prostitution stings, SWAT scouts and surveillance when other options are not available.

www.colorado.gov/ csp/1122 The Law Enforcement Support Office (LESO) within the Department of Defense (DoD), Defense Logistics Agency, facilitates the 1033 LESO program. This program allows transfer of excess DoD property that might otherwise be destroyed to law enforcement agencies across the United States.

Section 1122 of the National Defense Authorization Act authorizes state and local agencies to purchase equipment and supplies in support of counter-drug, homeland security, and emergency response activities through federal sources of supply. Agencies can take advantage of the volume buying power of the Federal Government for low prices.

#### **More Request Justifications**

#### Item: Saw, Hand, Crosscut

Justification: Our Sheriff's Department would use these saws to remove the antlers from elk and deer as the requirement of DOW when we issue road kill to the general public.

#### Item: Snow Blower

Justification: Our Sheriff's Department would be able to remove snow from the front of our office. Currently we use snow shovels and this would help with time, labor and fatigue of the lucky deputy who has to shovel.



#### Item: Bicycle

Justification: The police mountain bikes will be used by the Sheriff's Office to perform routine patrols and provide law enforcement presence on the extensive public trail system in the county. The bikes will also provide better access for deputies responding to calls for service in areas not accessible by vehicles and provide a means to have better tracking of illegal homeless camps on county property.

#### **Trivia Answer**

Answer: 34,155 tourniquets, 42,416 bandages, 162 defibrillators, and 6,146 sleeping bags were distributed in 2016.
