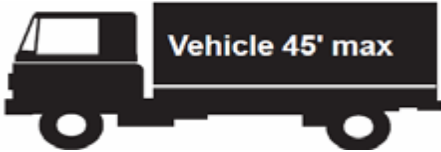


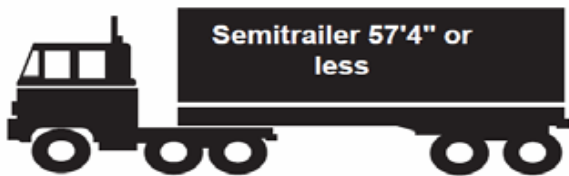
Colorado Length Limits



Single vehicle maximum length is **45'**.
C.R.S. 42-4-504(2)



Truck pulling a trailer maximum length is **70'**.
C.R.S. 42-2-504(4)



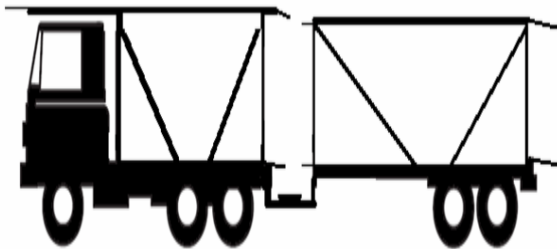
Unladen tractor pulling semi-trailer that is **57'4\"** or less has no overall length limit. If the semi-trailer exceeds **57'4\"** in length the overall length limit is **70'**. C.R.S. 42-4-504(4)



Unladen tractor semi-trailer, trailer combination where the trailer and semi-trailer lengths do not exceed **28'6\"**, there is no length limit. Should either the trailer or semi-trailer length exceed **28'6\"**, the overall length limit is **70'**. C.R.S. 42-4-504(4)



Saddle mount combinations consisting of no more than 4 units is allowed to operate up to **97'**
C.R.S.42-4-504(4.5)



Specialized automobile transporters **and laden truck-tractor semi-trailer combinations** are limited to **75'** in length. Extendable devices used for the loading and unloading of automobiles must be retracted when not supporting vehicles.
